Interventions for Equity 25/26

This will look like:

Numeracy

- Maths Recovery intervention for Q1 children not achieving expected levels in numeracy.
- Develop staff skills in teaching numeracy through high quality CLPL and engagement with the moderation cycle.
- Deliver our Numeracy Action Plan
- SALT to deliver 'Language of Maths' groups in P3-P7.
- Continue to embed robust assessment to ensure continued progress for learners.
- Staff to engage in practitioner enquiry to support interventions for our Q1 and Q2 children.
- Support the development of numeracy skills through high quality teaching resources and concrete materials.

This will look like:

Literacy

- All staff engage with pedagogy support for writing and implement, assess and plan learning for 'Core Writing Targets'.
- Deliver our Literacy Action Plan
- Speech and Language Therapist to deliver interventions and support for talking and listening.
- All staff continue to embed the use of 'Word Boost' and 'Teaching Children to Listen'
- Further develop pedagogy in teaching literacy through high quality professional learning with Literacy Pedagogy Officer and engagement with the moderation cycle.
- Staff to engage in practitioner enquiry to support interventions for our Q1 and O2 children.

This will look like:

Health and Wellbeing

- Ensure there are further planned, progressive opportunities to promote wellbeing and children's rights.
- Continue to embed the six principles of nurture across the school, PSWs consistently delivering appropriate interventions across all stages.
- Provide more opportunities for parental engagement.
- Continue to build staff knowledge of barriers to learning and provide strategies and skills to address these through engagement with the Attachment and Trauma Sensitive School Award (ATSSA)
